ELIGIBILITY:

Two criteria MUST be met:

- 1. It must be proven that your child has a severe functional loss; and,
- 2. Show expenses that are <u>specific</u> to your child's disability

*This means any expenses above the everyday cost of raising your child.

ONCE YOU'VE BEEN APPROVED:

- Cheques are deposited into your account by Direct Bank Deposit (DBD) on the last banking day of the month (for that month).
- You will receive a statement that will indicate the amount being deposited into your account.
- Drug and dental cards will be attached to and sent with your statement.
- Vision and hearing equipment must be pre-approved.

- Our purpose is to help parents meet the ongoing <u>additional</u> costs arising from their child's disability.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- 1. Complete and sign an ACSD application package, which includes:
 - a) Application form;
 - b) ACSD information sheet;
 - c) ACSD diagnostic form to be completed by your doctor; and,
 - d) Consent to release and verify information for your doctor.
- 2. You need to send us a copy of:
 - a) your (and when applicable, your spouse's) *Income Tax Notice of Assessment* from the previous year (which includes line 150);
 - b) your disabled child's birth verification (birth certificate) and health card
 - c) Alternate medical information if available; and,
 - d) A void cheque for Direct Bank Deposit.



YOUR RESPONSIBILITY:

To better serve you, we require that you accurately provide us with the following information:

- Complete review as requested, which may include a medical report from your doctor, expense review and/or Annual Report;
- Yearly <u>Income Tax Notice of</u> <u>Assessment</u> for the previous year (line 150);
- Immediately Report any Change in your:
 - Expenses;
 - Marital status and family size;
 - Address/living arrangements;
 - Children leaving/returning home/ if your child become 18 years of age/or if your child no longer needs this service;
 - Your child's Health Card number;
 - Direct Bank Deposit information (institution name and number, branch and bank account numbers); and,
 - Special diet, as per a doctor's report.

NOTE:

- <u>Right to appeal</u>: Should you disagree with the decisions made by the Ministry, you have the right to appeal in writing within specified time lines.
- <u>Subrogation:</u> Is when a person takes legal action for compensation because of an accident or malpractice. The Ministry can recover this money as part of the lawsuit.
- ACSD is <u>not</u> considered as <u>Taxable Income</u>, nor able to be garnisheed, or used as an asset/income.

MCSS/MCYS ALSO OFFERS:

Special Services at Home (SSAH):

SSAH Program is available to help individual with disabilities to live at home with their families. It provides funding, on a time-limited basis, to obtain respite (one-to-one) supports where services are not available elsewhere in the community.
